


WELCOME TO THE WORLD OF POLY CRISIS

The world is changing in unprecedented ways; we face a cascading series of global crises - climate change, rising inequality, uncontrolled consumption and pollution, financial instability, food insecurity, accelerating losses of topsoil, freshwater and biodiversity and to top it all off, a war that risks going nuclear and a deadly global pandemic.



The worst part is that these stressors interact, generating compounded catastrophic impacts driving us towards ecological tipping points of no return.

Governments are obsessed with growing their gross domestic product (GDP), and corporations work with a single goal in mind:

maximize profits. 0 In fact, in the last 100 years, our global economy

has grown 23 times over!

All this **growth** must be benefiting us, all right? Well, since 1980, half of all income growth has

gone to the wealthiest 5%. These are, of course, the elites that control the vast majority of capital and, as an extension, the cultural-socio-political landscape. Many in the global north did indeed benefit from richer material lives. This then drove resource and labour costs up, slowing down precious growth. So what did the benevolent capitalist do? Growth had to continue at all costs, so they decided to cheapen inputs. Practices like the privatization of the commons, deregulation, and shifting production to the poorer global south are all "cost-cutting" measures capitalists deploy to

sustain growth.

Another way to increase profits is to produce and sell as much as possible. Everything from technological innovations to efficiency improvements, from huge industrialized tools to sneaky advertisements, are now used to serve the capital overlords.

THE INSANITY OF FNDLESS ECONOMIC GROWTH

CODEX ALIMENTARIUS THE INFINITE GROWTH PARADIGM FINITE RESOURCES

THIS MAD PURSUIT OF ECONOMIC GROWTH HAS WREAKED HAVOC ON THE PLANET AND ITS PEOPLE.

IN THE LAST 12 & YEARS, OUR GLOBAL MATERIAL FOOTPRINT HAS GROWN FROM 7 BILLION TONS ANNUALLY TO 92 BILLION. IN THE SAME PERIOD, YEARLY CO2 EMISSIONS ROSE FROM 2 BILLION TO 37 BILLION TONS. WE'VE BREACHED SEVERAL CRITICAL PLANETARY BOUNDARIES, LIKE CLIMATE CHANGE, BIOSPHERE INTEGRITY, CHEMICAL POLLUTION, LAND USE CHANGE, AND PHOSPHORUS/NITROGEN CYCLES, TO NAME A FEW.

THE WORST PART IS THAT EVEN AFTER ALL THIS RESOURCE EXTRACTION AND ECOLOGICAL DESTRUCTION, HUMANITY STILL FAILS TO MEET ITS BASIC NEEDS AND SOCIAL OBJECTIVES.

WE'RE ALSO EXPERIENCING THE HIGHEST INEQUALITY LEVELS IN HUMAN HISTORY. THE WEALTHIEST 1% OWN 46% OF THE TOTAL WEALTH, WHILE THE POOREST 55% OWN 1% ... UNFAIR ARRANGEMENTS AND UNDEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS LIKE THE WORLD BANK AND WTO ALLOW THE NORTH TO DRAIN OVER TEN TRILLION DOLLARS OF WEALTH FROM GLOBAL SOUTH EVERY YEAR, GIVING BIRTH TO A NEW FORM OF COLONIALISM AND CONTINUED EXPLOITATION.

HOW DID GROWTH PESTROY US?

BUT MORE GROWTH WILL SAVE US FROM THE IMPENDING DOOM, RIGHT?

Many capitalists and leading politicians believe that the current ill effects of the capitalist economy are temporary and that everything will be fine with more growth. Eco-liberal economists say we need more green growth, a form of economic growth that can be decoupled from material use, energy use and environmental impacts.

We would also need around <u>2700% more Lithium</u> than we currently extract, <u>105% more silver</u>, <u>920% more Indium</u>, <u>and 100% copper</u>, all metals essential to building batteries, solar panels and wind turbines.


Decoupling is a Myth. Greek Growth is a Lie!

While it's possible to decouple emissions from GDP growth by transitioning to 100% renewable energy, It won't be fast enough to stay within the 1.5-2 C scenario if GDP continues doubling every 50 years.

SO WHAT NOW? DEGROWTH!

In response to the obvious inability of the everexpanding capitalist-colonial complex to satisfy human needs without degrading ecosystems, several intellectual and political movements over the past 50 years have given birth to the concept

of degrowth. Originally an anti-advertising political slogan, degrowth quickly became a real critique of the growth paradigm, an aspiration to bring the economy back into the public debate in order to try to "escape" from it.

This "missile word" aims to "decolonize our imaginary", long corrupted by the logic of exploitation and accumulation. In simple terms, degrowth not only calls for a different economic system but also for us to self-reflect and imagine alternatives to go beyond the society of growth.




To begin with, degrowth is a voluntary **reduction** of production and consumption.

Producing and consuming **less** to produce and consume **better**. What good are SUVs and luxury watches when a large part of the population doesn't have access to essential services like healthcare?

ECOLOGICAL SUSTAINABILITY.

We have already seen that western production and consumption levels are incompatible with planetary limits. The planet can no longer bear our excesses; it is time to go on a diet.

It is necessary to redistribute wealth, media, and political power and repair past injustices locally and globally. No more appropriation, exploitation, and accumulation but sharing so that everyone has access to dignified material conditions of existence.

WELL-BEING.

Rather than focusing on material wealth, we need to focus on that which makes life worth living. Well-being means living a dignified life, sharing, leisure, eating together, relationality, dancing and napping!

Degrowth calls for us to use a matrix of alternatives and solidarity to bring about this change. We need trade unions, land defenders, activists, academics, politicians and you to use a pluriverse of ideas, strategies and actions to decolonize our imaginaries so we can imagine a better world.

It will also need a wide pange of policies enacted that will pequipe significant changes to the way we live and do business. There are a few key steps that must all be done in unison that can help us move towards a degrowth society.



UNIVERSAL BASIC SERVICES

The system for many in the global North actively encourages carbon-intensive lifestyles. Many folks have no choice but to take the car to work or produce things they don't need because they have to work to pay off their mortgage, medical debt, school loans etc. Degrowth advocates for an increase in public provisioning services such as education, housing, healthcare, clean energy transportation, nutritious food etc. Doing so gives people what they need to live a dignified non-carbon-intensive life. This could involve implementing new regulations, such as caps on interest rates, 100% reserve rates for banks and banning risky speculative trading. Democratising international development banks such as the IMF and World Bank would stop them from conditioning finance for the global South on neoliberal policy implementations. This would also require cancelling unfair debt and stopping the massive wealth drain from the South to the North.

REFORM THE FINANCIAL SYSTEM

REDISTRIBUTE WEALTH AND RESOURCES

We know that the rich are responsible for a majority share of the world's emissions. A more equitable society could reduce their purchasing power of carbon-intensive and less necessary goods. Maximum income caps, wealth taxes and progressive taxation policies could redistribute wealth through social welfare programs. It could also involve promoting local control and community ownership of resources, such as land and natural resources.





CHANGE OUR MINDSET

Ultimately, achieving degrowth will require a fundamental shift in our way of thinking. We must decolonise our minds and move towards a more holistic and sustainable approach that prioritises human well-being and respects planetary boundaries. This will require changes to our education system, media, and cultural values to promote a more sustainable and equitable way of life.

If we are willing to embrace this challenge, the rewards could be enormous. A degrowth society would be more sustainable, equitable, resilient and better equipped to deal with the challenges of the 21st century. So how will you help degrow?
